The Lambley Car Park

For the past two Fridays, The Lambley Village Kitchen car park has been closed due to events being held. We are really grateful that they allow parents and visitors to use their car park at drop off and pick up times most days and only close the car park off if they are hosting large events. This was the case last Friday as they were hosting two wakes. Nearly all parents adhered to their polite request but sadly some ignored it or missed the message. This meant caused disruption to the event and upset and it is important that we avoid any such problems in the future. The pub hold Wakes/ funeral receptions on a daily basis, most of which do not impact on our school pick up or drop off time. On some occasions, due to timings, the car park needs to be left available to customers and Wake party.

I would like to encourage members of our school community who use their car park to show courtesy. They have asked that school drop offs in the morning take care to not block access for delivery vehicles. This means that you can not leave your car parked there for a length of time, it needs to be a quick drop off. Similarly at the end of the school day, please refrain from using the pub car park if you intend to go and used the public park. We have also received a report that some families go in to use the pub toilets without even stopping to buy a drink. This is clearly taking advantage of the good nature of the owners and I request that it stops. Public Houses are not public property so you have no right to use their facilities unless you are a paying customer.
