All parents & carers are invited to attend Parents' Forum, this Wednesday evening at 6:30pm in the Village Hall. This is a chance to share your views and ideas for further improving our school and to discuss things that have been happening.

School Reports

This Thursday we will be sending home your child's school report and attendance record for the year. This reports contains information on what your child has learnt throughout the year and the progress they have made in Reading, Writing and Maths. It also shares with you their next step target for both English and Maths and their assessment record.

- If you have a Y6 pupil, it will also tell you your child's SATS scaled score for Reading, GPS (Grammar Punctuation & Spelling) and Maths. A score of 100 or above indicates that they have achieved the 'expected standard' for a child their age.
- In KS1, the Y2 pupils SATS performance has been used to inform the teacher assessment that Miss Hall has made. Please note that these teacher assessments have been externally moderated looking at evidence collected throughout the year, including the SATS papers.
- Y1 pupils completed the Y1 Phonics Screening check so information will also be coming home to tell you whether they achieved the expected standard in this area.

Please take the time to complete the reply slip and feedback form included with your child's end of year report.

Fundraising

As you have already been made aware, we are suffering the effects of a tightened school budget. As a result, we have listed things we would love to purchase but presently don't have the funds to get and are calling this our 'Wish List'. Things on this list are all things that teachers feel will improve our school ad the learning experiences of our pupils. We wanted to make you aware of our wish list so you know what future fundraising activities will be focusing on.

- Science practical resources to deliver the KS1 & KS2 curriculum in a hands on way through investigative science- £600 in the first instance
- Mastering Maths Work Books (This spend will be fund matched because we are part
 of a national 2-year research project and we would like to make the most of this
 opportunity) £2000
- i-pads/ tables for whole class sessions (1 between 2 pupils so 16 needed)- Cost of 16 i-pads and air server apps.
- Base 10/ Diennes maths resource-£180
- Milk Crates & large construction materials for outside EYFS- not sure of cost
- Reading Books for KS1 and EYFS- Further £200 *A donation has now been received!
- Guided Reading Scheme/ Structure for KS1 & KS2 to follow
- NFER Assessment materials (Mrs Shardlow to investigate price)
- Twinkle School Licence £550
- Tapestry (An online resource for EYFS where parents can access their learning journals from home and to ensure efficiency in adults gathering assessment information on a day to day basis) £75.00
- Signage- so visitors know the way into school and stop going to the Village Hall by mistake – not sure of cost
- Pupil Badges £100 (estimate) *A sponsor has now stepped forward!
