History Curriculum

We offer the children a broad and balanced curriculum which builds on their knowledge, skills and understanding of history each year. Through the use of visitors & visits, drama and historical evidence, children will leave Lambley Primary with understanding of how beliefs and cultures affect peoples actions. They will understand why events have happened and what we can learn as a society from these periods in history. They will also have a chronological framework for their knowledge of significant events and people and will be able to talk about their impact on our world today.
