



2016 Results

We are proud to share with you our 2016 results. The new assessments this year, as part of significant national changes, have presented challenges for pupils and staff who worked really hard to do their best.

We want to take the opportunity to thank the parents who did so much to support their children both academically and emotionally during this challenging time.

Foundation Stage

Our Good Level of Development score increased from 55% in 2015 to 68% in 2016, which is above both the district and the national average.

Key Stage One

75% of our Y1 pupils met the expected standard in Phonics this year, a drop from 81% in 2015. This slight dip represents 1 child less than the previous year.

Our Y2 pupils made good progress across the Key Stage and our attainment scores were higher than both National and District averages.

Key Stage Two

We are particularly proud of the Y6 pupils who took part in statutory assessments for a four-year curriculum that had only been brought in two years earlier. The increased demands of the new curriculum resulted in a drop in attainment nationally and this also impacted our school, particularly in Reading.

Despite this, we out performed both the district and the national attainment scores.

The progress of our Y6 pupils across the Key Stage exceeded the National floor standard but progress in Reading was lower than that of Writing and Maths. This subject has been identified as a focus for School Improvement for these next two years as we want to ensure that all pupils progress well based on their starting points.
