#### Homework and spellings

As per usual, homework will be given to the children on a Wednesday, to be collected the following Wednesday. The homework will relate to either the topic or maths work that the children have been focusing on during lessons. Spellings will also be given out on a Monday and will be tested the following Monday. I will give children 6 spellings per week to learn this half term. Children will be given a spellings book, which they will be able to take home for you to monitor their progress. Their book must be returned in their book bags on Mondays.

Their book bags are placed in a book bag box in the morning, which allow staff to quickly change reading books and hand out letters and information.
