### **Pupil Planners**

Your child should have a Pupil Planner. In this there is lots of information to support your child at home. Key words for each year groups, multiplication grids and key mathematical terminology. There is also a 'home school agreement' which we would appreciate you reading with your child and

signing.

We would also ask that you read with your child as often as possible, ask your child questions about what they have read. Please also remember to number each of the reads, this makes it easier when we are counting up who needs reading certificates in our celebration assemblies.

Please note that for the reading awards we only count **1** quality read per day that takes place out of the school day.

### **School Uniform**

Please ensure that your child comes to school every day in the correct uniform.

A royal blue jumper or cardigan

A white or royal blue polo shirt or white shirt with a collar

Tailored trousers in black or dark grey, a skirt or pinafore dress also in black or dark grey (please no jeans).

Checked summer dresses

Plain black school shoes – please no trainers

Tights should be black, white or dark grey, socks should be black, white or dark grey.

Please ensure that head wear is subtle and we advise that long hair is tired back.

A warm sensible coat is also required for the colder months.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT NAMES ARE IN ALL PIECES OF UNIFORM

Jeans or leggings are not permitted even if they are black.

Any changes that need to be made to the school uniform due to religious reasons please pop in and see a member of staff

### **PE kits**

Please ensure that children have PE kits in school, please leave the PE kit in school we will send them home for washing at the end of each half term. We are no longer allowing children to 'borrow' other children PE kits, this has become quite disruptive to the learning of other pupils. Please ensure that your child's PE kit is **named** (including the trainers) and that it consists of:

- A white t-shirt or a plain t-shirt in your child's house colour. The house colours are
  - Cromwell = red
  - Flamstead = yellow
  - Pearson = green
  - Trinity = blue
- Black/Navy shorts
- A black or dark blue tracksuit (for colder days)
- Trainers or plimsolls

Please no denim shorts or Sports tops.

Please also ensure that your child is not wearing any jewellery on PE days (except for religious purposes)

### Jewellery and accessories

One pair of stud earrings are permitted but should not be worn on PE days. Staff are unable to remove earrings. A discrete piece of jewellery is also permitted for religious reasons. We do encourage children to wear watches, please ensure that this is not expensive and that it is unable to take photos.

Nail polish is not permitted.

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Headwear should be discrete and in school colours. No big bright bows or cat ears are permitted.

### **Water Bottles**

Please also ensure that your child has a water bottle in school every day. It is very important that they stay hydrated throughout the day.

### Medicine

If your child requires any mediation to be taken in school then please see Mrs Newton in the school office. We are only allowed to give medication that is in the original packaging and that is named. We will need you to fill out a form before we are able to administer any medication.

### **Asthma**

If your child is asthmatic and require an inhaler please ensure that they have an inhaler in school with their name on it. Please also ensure that a medical form has been completed.

### **Parking**

A polite reminder that we are now able to use the Lambley car park. Please ensure that only the designated school spaces are used. We also ask that when you are notified of the car park being unavailable to use, that you find alternative parking in a safe place. We understand that this may require you to walk further and therefore school will be more lenient on these days.

### Squid

We are now working towards becoming a cashless school and dinner money should now be paid through your Squid account. Please make sure that you have registered to use this facility.
