Dear Parents/Carers,

In the meantime, I wanted to write to you today in response to the Government's announcement yesterday afternoon. As I am sure you are already aware, Nottinghamshire has now been placed into Tier 4. Furthermore, they announced that 'most' primary schools would be reopening on Monday 4th January 2021.

I wanted to take this opportunity to reassure you that (in-line with current guidance) we will be open on Monday 4th January 2021. As I hope you appreciate, this is an ever-changing situation and could in the future change. If there are any further government changes, I will let you know as soon as possible.

As we are opening on Monday 4th January 2021, can I also remind you of the importance of our staggered times and protocols when approaching and leaving school. In-line with current guidance, our school day will remain the same and so the staggered start and end times, that have been in place since September, will remain in place from next Monday onwards.
