I appreciate that there are not a lot of parking spaces in and around school, but wanted to send a reminder/plea from me—please be considerate and mindful of everyone's safety when parking before and after school.

The roads around school are busy and parents, carers and children are regularly crossing the road at these key times. There are buses that drop-off and collect children every day at these key times too.
