## Home Time Arrangements

Dear Parents/Carers,

Having started our new staggered times last week and having listened to your feedback, school are going to trial a subtle change to our home time arrangements. This trial will take place between Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> September and half term (Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> October). If successful, school will make this change permanent.

It is important to stress that the start and end times for each Key Stage **will remain the same** but there will be a subtle change for those of you with children in both Key Stages. Please read the information below:

### **What are the school's start and end times?**

**Reception/Key Stage 1 (Y1-2) Start:** 9:10am (gate opens at 9am) (Reception class enter via the main gate. Y1/2 enter via the side gate near the committee room)

**Reception/Key Stage 1 (Y1-2) End:** 3:30pm (Reception class leave via the main gate. Y1/2 leave via the side gate near the committee room)

**Key Stage 2 (Y3-Y6) Start:** 8:50am (gate opens at 8:40am) (enter via the main gate)

**Key Stage 2 (Y3-Y6) End:** 3:15pm (leave via the main gate)

**If you have children in both key stages:** Please arrive at school by 8:50am (enter via the main gate)

### **What are the arrangements for home time?**

School are proposing a subtle change for those of you with children in both Key Stages. Please read the following carefully. If you...

Only have one child and they are in Reception/Key Stage 1 – **collect your child at 3:30pm**

Only have one child and they are in Key Stage 2 – **collect your child at 3:15pm**

Have more than one child (but they are all in Reception/Key stage 1) – **collect at 3:30pm**

Have more than one child (but they are all in Key Stage 2) – **collect at 3:15pm**

**Change that we are going to trial:**

Have more than 1 child and they are in **different** Key Stages – **Collect BOTH/ALL at 3:30pm**

Rather than collecting your Key Stage 2 child at 3:15pm and then waiting 15 minutes. We are proposing that both/all of your children are collected at 3:30pm. The children in Key Stage 2 (who are waiting to be collected with their younger siblings) will go to the hall with a member of staff. You will then be able to collect all your children together at 3:30pm. Reception children and Key Stage 2 siblings will be collected from the main gate. Y1 or Y2 children and their Key Stage 2 siblings will be collected from the side gate.
