

School Uniform Policy

June 2022

All Lambley Primary School children are expected to wear school uniform. We believe this helps to create a sense of belonging and pride in the school and adds to the purposeful environment.

All items of school uniform that bear the Lambley Primary School logo are available from Ginger Roots. These items include blue cardigans, sweatshirts, polo shirts, fleeces and book bags. These items are non-compulsory and pupils can wear equivalent items without the logo, available from supermarkets and many well-known retail shops.

Our School Uniform requirements are as follows:

- Tailored trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore in dark grey or black.
- A white or royal blue polo shirt, cotton shirt or blouse with a collar
- A royal blue cardigan, jumper and/or school fleece.
- Plain black school shoes
- If children wear tights, we ask that these be grey or black. We ask that socks also be in black, white or grey so that they blend in with the rest of the uniform.
- A warm sensible coat will also be required.

Please note that jeans and leggings are not permitted, even if they are black.

Jewellery and accessories:

We want to encourage independence by allowing pupils to wear a watch. If your child wishes to wear a wristwatch, we advise that this should be inexpensive. Apple watches and wrist watches with the capacity of taking images and accessing the internet are not permitted for safeguarding reasons.

Headbands/ accessories should be discreet with no oversized bright bows or themed headbands. Nail varnish is not appropriate.

PE KIT:

For Health & Safety reasons, all jewellery and watches should be removed for PE lessons and school sport.

- Trainers for outdoor P.E. (and KS2 indoor sports)
- black plimsolls (EYFS and KS1 pupils for indoor PE).
- plain black shorts, black sports leggings or plain black tracksuit bottoms
- a white t-shirt.
