Supported by Nottinghamshire Cricket Club and Mr. Clayton, all children developed key cricket skills and were able to apply this in small games and activities. The coaches from Notts CC were very impressed with not only the children's behaviour but their cricketing prowess!

Whilst talking sport, I am also very proud to say that both the boy's and girl's football teams competed last week in their Cup Quarter-Final matches and both won and are heading into the Semi-Finals! Mr. Conroy and Mr. Clayton took the boys to Arno Vale where they won 2-1 (from 1-0 down!) thanks to two goals from striker Henry B.
